Mae West was doubly famous: she was a sex symbol and a comedian whose one-liners were as clever as anyone's. She was the #1 box-office attraction in Hollywood for several years, and although she always played a type, she played it to perfection. She was a performer from childhood and debuted on Broadway in a play she wrote entitled "Sex" which was a success until it was raided for immorality and Mae was jailed for ten days. Her first starring role in Hollywood was in 1932 when she played opposite George Raft and every picture she made in the 1930s was a box-office success. She made two films with Cary Grant, helping to launch his career. Charlotte Chandler recorded Mae West over a period of roughly a month toward the end of the star's life. The former ambassador to both Syria and Israel and recent advisor to the Iraq Study Group explains the forces at play in the contemporary Arab and Muslim worlds, and provide value insight for understanding and responding to the critical challenges currently facing our government. Edward Djerejian has been Ambassador to both Syria and Israel, has served under Democratic and Republican presidents going back to the Kennedy administration, and served as the Chairman of the Advisory Group on Public Diplomacy in the Arab and Muslim Worlds under then-Secretary of State Colin Powell. In this first novel in a debut trilogy, adventure, romance, and the magic of Arthurian legend are brought to new light in Anna Elliott's retelling of the timeless legends of Trystan and Isolde. Isolde, a strong and independent young woman and former High Queen of England, must navigate the warring kingdoms of Britain after King Arthur's death. Queen Isolde grieves for her slain husband, the High King Constantine, Arthur's heir. Bob Dylan's newly rediscovered manuscript of early poetry, inspired by the Hollywood photographs of legendary lensman Barry Feinstein, is a never-before-published illustrated collection of the observations and ruminations of a pop culture legend. Inspired by a series of photographs that Feinstein took in Hollywood during the 1950s and 1960s, Dylan wrote an extraordinary series of poems that have remained unpublished for decades. They are thought-provoking, witty, and erudite observations of the world and through the lens of Feinstein's photographs, they speak volumes about the anonymous faces and places of Los Angeles. Photos of Frank Sinatra, Marlene Dietrich, Judy Garland float through the book, as do poignant images of starlets, casting couches, employment agencies, and palm tree'd boulevards. Feinstein was there with a camera to capture some world-famous events, such as Marilyn Monroe's memorial service. Bob Dylan's distinctly unique perspective informs and enlivens every page, an irresistible interpretive voice narrating the visual images from photo to photo. The book, with an estimated 160 pages, will have a larger format to showcase approximately 70-75 black-and-white photographs printed with a four-color process.
